Vanguard Voices' performances in its 28th season will explore the symbolism of the rose in poetry, song and composition. The season begins with a much-anticipated collaboration with the Archdiocesan Chorus of Detroit. The two choirs will present an early December concert performance of Steven Errante's *The Boar's Head Festival* in the stunning setting of Cathedral of the Most Blessed Sacrament. This much-loved work will be repeated by Vanguard Voices the following day at Cherry Hill Presbyterian Church in Dearborn, where Errante dedicated the hour-long holiday favorite in 1972.

The annual Dearborn Holiday Choral Festival will pair Vanguard Voices with the Dearborn Community Chorus and Dearborn Public Schools Elementary Honors Choir in a performance of Cecilia McDowall's *Christus Natus Est: A Cantata for Christmas.* Vanguard Voices also will perform its own holiday selections, including John Joubert's *There Is No Rose* and Herbert Howells' *A Spotless Rose.*

In late February, Vanguard Voices will join with other Henry Ford College vocal and instrumental ensembles in the 25th President's Collage Concert. Always an audience favorite, the 90-minute program encompasses the variety of musical styles the college offers, from ancient chant to modern jazz.

Two mid-May concerts by Vanguard Voices & Brass will be filled with rose musical imagery. The major work to be performed is Morten Lauridsen's *Les Chansons des Roses*, the five-song cycle based on poems by Rainer Maria Rilke. Other works range from the 16th Century *Ah le guancie de rose* by Andreas Gabrieli and 17th Century Orlando Gibbons' *Fair is the Rose* to the Irish folksong *The Last Rose of Summer* to Meredith Willson's Broadway chestnut *Lida Rose* and local composer Stuart Scott's *Red, Red Rose*.
